FROGS on a Lily PAD™

Object:

The object of Frogs on a Lily Pad is to collect the most frogs.

Set Up:

Spread out the 24 frog cards, number side up, on the table (this is called the Frog Pond).

How To Play:

Pick a starter (youngest first, shortest, etc.). The first player spins the spinner and picks a card from the frog pond with the same number as their spinner. S/he flips the card over to reveal the number of Frogs (some cards have zero frogs). The card is then placed frog side up in front of the player. Play passes to the player on the right.

If the spinner lands on a number and there are no cards left with that number, the player's turn is lost and play passes to the right.

The End:

The game ends when all the cards in the Frog Pond are gone. The players then count the total number of frogs they collected. The player with the most frogs wins.
