



Object:

The object of My Grocery List is to be the first player to collect all the groceries on their list.

Set Up:

Remove the 30 Grocery Cards from the cardboard sheets (parental assistance required). Mix up the cards and place them picture side down on the table (or any flat surface). Arrange them in 6 rows across and 5 columns down to create a rectangular shape (playable table). Next pass out one Grocery List Card and one Shopping Basket Card to each player.

How To Play:

Pick a starter (youngest first, shortest, etc.). Players take turns flipping over one grocery card at a time to reveal the hidden groceries. The grocery card must be shown to all the players.

A match – If the player matches one of the grocery cards to a grocery item on his/her list, he or she takes the grocery card and places it in his or her shopping basket. Play then moves to the next player.

A miss – If the player fails to match the grocery card to a grocery item on his/her list, he or she turns the grocery card back over (grocery down), in the same place in the playable table, and ends his/her turn. Play moves to the next player.

The End:

The game ends when one player collects all the groceries on his/her grocery list. The first player to collect all of the groceries on their list is the winner.
