Jane Austen's *PRIDE and PREJUDICE* Trivia Game

The Object:

Be the first person to get 25 points by correctly answering trivia questions directly from Jane Austen's novel - Pride and Prejudice.

The Set Up:

- Remove trivia card box lid.
- Remove score pad and die.
- Determine who will keep score.
- Determine if you will play as individuals or teams.
- Put each player/teams name or initials on the score pad.

The Start:

Each player/team rolls the die. The player/team with the highest roll goes first. Play continues to the right.

The Play:

The starting player/team rolls the die. The player/team to their right draws a trivia card and reads the question. The rolling player/team then answers the question. If the player/team gets the correct answer, they score the amount of points indicated on the die and roll again repeating the above steps. If the player/team gets the incorrect answer, play passes to the player/team on their right. Play continues until one player/team reaches 25 points or more. Once a question has been asked, return the card to the back of the Trivia Card box. If the player/team draws a Free Points card, they automatically get the points indicated on the die without having to answer a trivia question. After the card has been returned to the trivia card box, play passes to the player on their right. You do not get to roll again if you get a Free Points card.

The Winner:

The winner is the first player to reach 25 points and claims the rights of the Pride and Prejudice Trivia Champion.

Variations:

Prior to starting, players may agree to make the game harder or easier by following these suggestions:

Harder - Require answers to be exact. If the question asks what one character said to another, require the quote to be exactly as stated on the card.

Easier - Allow answers to be paraphrases or the gist of the answer.
